2008 Black Seaweed Contest Rules

Sealaska Heritage Institute will hold a Black Seaweed Contest during Celebration 2008, June 5-7. The Grand prize for the seaweed King or Queen will be \$500.00; Second Prize \$250.00; and Third Prize \$100.00.

The rules to participate are similar to participating in other events sponsored by the Sealaska Heritage Institute.

1. Seaweed must be gathered and prepared by participant.
2. Each participant must submit at least a 1-quart size bag of seaweed.
3. Entry forms must be postmarked by Friday, May 30, 2008.
4. Each bag of seaweed must be marked with the participant's name, and a phone number where they can be reached. Please mark this information directly on the bag. Do not attach notes to the bags, as they may be lost.
5. Before judging, the names will be replaced with numbers to keep contestants' names secret from the judges.
6. Any surplus seaweed will be donated on behalf of the participant to elders living in urban communities.

Seaweed entries may be mailed to SHI in advance at the above address, dropped off at SHI's Juneau office at Sealaska Plaza or brought in to Centennial Hall, General Information Booth, by 5 pm, Thursday, June 5. Entry forms must be postmarked by Friday, May 30, 2008.

Check the Celebration Program for time and location of judging. The winners of the contest will be announced on the main stage of Centennial Hall.
