



SEALASKA HERITAGE INSTITUTE JURIED ARTS SHOW GUIDELINES

Sealaska Heritage Institute's Juried Arts Show and Competition follows the same policies as delineated in our overall "Native Artist Policy and Standards," with the following additional guidelines:

The Selection Process:

The juror will review all images submitted with applications and select artwork based upon the quality of the artwork in the images. The juror reserves the right to disqualify pieces upon receipt that do not reflect the quality of the work portrayed in the slides, digital images, or photos.

Artwork Requirements:

1. Artwork may not exceed 8' x 8' x 8'
2. Artists are limited to submitting no more than **three** pieces.
3. Each entry must be designated under one of two categories: contemporary or traditional.
4. Limited use of manufactured material is required for artwork in the traditional category.
5. Commercially reproduced artwork is prohibited even if the artist produced the original.
6. Prints and bronze sculptures are allowed but must be hand pulled, carved or fabricated and limited to an edition of 200 copies, signed and numbered.
7. All artwork entered must be solely owned and controlled by the artist and cannot be in the control of any gallery, show, collector, clan or tribe.
8. Because of the provisions of the Endangered Species Act, it is the responsibility of the artist to ensure any use of parts from an endangered species are explicitly allowed by law.

Artwork Labels:

Each artist must attach and secure a completed and signed identification label, including the date of production, to the back of each piece submitted and accepted by the show. Artwork without a label will be returned to the artist at his/her own expense.

Show Display:

1. Sealaska Heritage Institute shall solely be responsible for the display of entries that are accepted to be a part of the show.
2. Although SHI will exercise care in handling the artwork, we are not responsible for the loss or damage of work.
3. All work displayed shall identify the name of artist, tribal affiliation, medium, category and title of the piece.

4. All work selected for the show can be sold during the show but cannot be removed until the closing of the show (TBA).

Shipping and Handling:

1. SHI must receive selected artwork by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, **May 3, 2010**.
2. Artwork accepted for the show, if shipped, must be sent to SHI prepaid.
3. All pieces must be packaged individually. Do not combine shipping of multiple pieces.

GENERAL RULES:

1. Artists misrepresenting themselves or their art will be disqualified from the show.
2. SHI staff and sponsors cannot accept gifts from artists. Gifts can be donated to Sealaska Heritage Institute.
3. SHI will not be responsible for artwork or materials used in the displaying of artwork. Artists should secure appropriate coverage to protect their work if deemed necessary.
4. Please make sure to complete the standard application along with the biography form. You may provide a photo of yourself. If you are selected to be in the show, the bio, photo, and images of artwork will be used for promotional purposes, including the Sealaska Heritage website. (www.sealaskaheritage.org)
5. APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETE AND POSTMARKED BY **MARCH 31, 2010**. SHI WILL NOTIFY ARTISTS OF THEIR STATUS NO LATER THAN **APRIL 15, 2010**.

SHI recognizes only those individuals who meet one of the following criteria as **eligible to participate**:

- ❖ Alaska Natives who are defined as “Native” under the Alaska Native Settlement Act, 443 U.S.C.A. 1602(b) enrolled to Sealaska Corporation; or
- ❖ Descendants of Alaska Natives enrolled to Sealaska Corporation, whether they own Sealaska Corporation stock or not; or
- ❖ Alaska Natives and Native Americans who are members of an ANCSA corporation or Indian Tribe or who are certified as an Indian Artisan by an Indian Tribe.

Applications will not be accepted unless completed and returned with (pgs. 1-5), necessary documentation that demonstrates eligibility as outlined above, and nonrefundable application fee.

- 10) I authorize the use of my name, biography, and address for educational, promotional, cultural purposes or public requests for names of artists.

Fees per Artist:

Native Artist Market:

Artists must submit a non-refundable application fee of \$25. Selected artists must pay an additional fee of \$100 (60) days prior to the Celebration Native Artist Market for one table and two chairs. **Do not send the \$100 table fee until notified of selection on March 12th.**

The exhibition fee of \$100 will include:

- (1) 30" wide x 6' long table
- Table covering and skirting
- 1 chair (2 for shared booths)
- Booth-piping and drapes
- One table sign with artist name/tribal affiliation

Juried Art Show:

Artists must submit a non-refundable application fee of \$25. Artist will also pay SHI a 15% commission of the sale price of each art object sold.

SHI reserves the right to deny participation in its Native Artist Markets if artists fail to comply with the Native Artist Policy and Standards as outlined. Please mail any requests for appeal to the SHI President at Sealaska Heritage Institute, One Sealaska Plaza, Suite 301, Juneau, AK 99801. All appeals must be made in writin
