## 2010 Black Seaweed Contest

Sealaska Heritage Institute will hold a "Seaweed Contest" during Celebration 2010, June 3-5. The Grand prize for the seaweed King or Queen will be \$500.00; Second Prize \$250.00; and Third Prize \$100.00.

The rules to participate are similar to participating in other events sponsored by the Sealaska Heritage Institute.

1. Seaweed must be gathered and prepared by participant.
2. Each participant must submit at least a 1-quart size bag of seaweed.
3. Each bag of seaweed must be marked with the participant's name, and a local phone number they can be reached at. Please mark this information directly on the bag. Please do not attach notes to the bags, as they are more likely to be lost.
4. Before judging the names will be matched with numbers so as to keep the name secret from the judges.
5. Any surplus seaweed will be donated on behalf of the participant to elders living in urban communities.

Seaweed entries can be mailed to SHI [Sealaska Heritage Institute, Attn: Seaweed Contest Coordinator, One Sealaska Plaza Suite 301, Juneau Alaska 99801] in advance, dropped off at the SHI offices or brought in to Centennial Hall the first day of Celebration to the General Information Booth by 5 pm on Thursday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The time and location of the judging is Thursday, June 3, 2010 from 7:00-9:00 pm, in the Elders Room at Centennial Hall. The winners of the contest will be announced on the main stage of Centennial Hall at 6:30 pm on Friday.
