

whose area the mineral is found, and 50% to be divided among all of the other regional corporations on a population basis.

4. The lands withdrawn and conveyed to the villages may be located in National Parks, National Wildlife Refuges, National Forests, unimproved portions of Military Reservations, and various animal or bird sanctuaries. AFN respectfully submits that such withdrawals were made without any consideration to the Native occupants and that, equitably, the land in those withdrawals should be restored to the occupants.
5. All Indian Reorganization Act reserves, Executive Order reserves, and Administrative reserves (Pages 444 and 445 of "Alaska Natives and The Land", prepared by the Federal Field Committee for Development Planning in Alaska), which have been set aside for Native use or for the administration of Native affairs, should be granted subject to valid existing rights, to the villages using or occupying the land at the time of the passage of the
