PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION

1. AFN proposes a payment of \$500,000,000 and an overriding gross royalty of 2% of all proceeds from any state and federal lands as compensation for lands previously taken, and as compensation for the extinguishment of any and all claims against the United States, based upon aboriginal rights to all of the lands in Alaska. Sums should be apportioned 75% to the villages, 20% to the regional corporations, and 5% to the statewide corporation after native enrolment is completed. The apportionment should be on the basis of population.

The above distribution of compensation will be limited as to two particular groups:

- a) The Tlingit-Haida Indians, who were granted a judgment in the Court of Claims Docket No. 47,900;
- b) Those villages who have claims pending before the Indian Claims Commission that may be reduced to judgment before the legislation passes.

As to those two groups, the amount of any judgments, after deducting the payment of attorneys' fees and costs, should be withheld and reapportioned among
