

1 and corporations organized pursuant to this Act, without  
 2 (1) establishing any permanent racially defined institutions,  
 3 rights, privileges or obligations, (2) creating a reservation  
 4 system or lengthy trusteeship, or (3) ultimately adding to  
 5 the categories of property and organization enjoying special  
 6 tax privileges or to the legislation establishing special rela-  
 7 tionships between the United States Government and the  
 8 State of Alaska.

9 (c) No provision of this Act is intended to replace,  
 10 diminish or otherwise modify any right, privilege, or obliga-  
 11 tion of Alaska Natives as citizens of the United States and  
 12 the State of Alaska, nor to relieve, replace, or diminish  
 13 any obligation of the United States or the State to protect  
 14 and promote the rights and welfare of Alaska Natives. The  
 15 payments and grants authorized under section 5 of this Act  
 16 constitute compensation for the extinguishment of property  
 17 rights, and shall not be deemed a substitute for any govern-  
 18 mental programs otherwise available to the Natives of  
 19 Alaska in accordance with the laws applicable to Indian  
 20 affairs.
