

1 that the action of the Commission be modified or set aside
2 in whole or in part. A copy of the petition shall forthwith
3 be sent by registered or certified mail to any other party
4 to the proceeding and to the Commission, and thereupon
5 the Commission shall certify and file in such court the record
6 upon which the decision complained of was based. The
7 court shall hear such appeal on the record made before the
8 Commission. The findings of the Commission, if supported
9 by substantial evidence on the record considered as a whole,
10 shall be conclusive. The court may affirm, vacate, or modify
11 any decision or may remand the proceeding to the Com-
12 mission for such further action as it directs. The judgment of
13 the court shall be subject to review by the United States
14 Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, and by the Supreme
15 Court of the United States upon certiorari or certification
16 as provided in section 1254, title 28, United States Code.

17 (k) The duties and responsibilities of the Commission
18 shall include during the period of its existence—

19 (1) the issuance of rules and regulations for pre-
20 paring a final membership roll of Alaskan Natives and
