

1 the effective date of this Act; and (B) a roster of Native
2 villages, which shall be in addition to those Native villages
3 specified in section 10 (c), eligible for benefits hereunder,
4 within three years after the effective date of this Act. Before
5 any such roll or roster is finally approved by the Commission,
6 it shall be published in the Federal Register and in such
7 other manner as the Commission shall find practicable and
8 effective (including posting in each Native village listed in
9 section 10 (c)), and any applicant denied enrollment or
10 omitted from the roster also shall be notified concurrently in
11 writing of the Commission's action and of his right to pro-
12 test such action.

13 (2) Within three months after notice of the Commis-
14 sion's action, any person or village denied enrollment or
15 omitted from the roster, as the case may be, shall have the
16 right to protest such denial or omission to the Commission,
17 and within three months after publication in the Federal Reg-
18 ister, the Secretary or any Native village listed in section
19 10 (c) shall have the right to protest to the Commission the
20 inclusion of any individual on the membership roll or any
21 village on the roster of Native villages. Any Native village
22 shall have the right to protest a designation of membership
23 therein by a Native on behalf of himself or his children below
24 the age of nineteen under subsection (d) hereof, within
