 2 Federal Register. Such protests shall be the subject of a  
 3 hearing by the Commission and judicial review as provided  
 4 in section 6 or this Act. The membership roll and village  
 5 roster prepared by the Commission, as modified after such  
 6 hearings and judicial review, shall be final and shall be prom-  
 7 ulgated by publication in the Federal Register.

8 (c) The Commission shall establish procedures for main-  
 9 taining a membership roll containing the names of Natives,  
 10 as defined in section 3 (d) hereof, born during the twenty-  
 11 year period after December 31 of the year in which this Act  
 12 becomes law. The Commission shall publish lists of such  
 13 names from time to time in accordance with subsection (b)  
 14 (1) hereof, and the denial or allowance of enrollment shall  
 15 be subject to protest in accordance with subsection (b) (2)  
 16 hereof. A person listed on the afterborn membership roll pur-  
 17 suant to this paragraph shall be entitled to the benefits con-  
 18 ferred upon the Natives of Alaska under this Act as of the  
 19 date of his or her birth: *Provided*, That Natives born after  
 20 December 31 of the year in which this Act becomes law shall  
 21 not be entitled to membership in the Corporation.

22 (d) Each Native shall have the right to designate the  
 23 Native village in which he and his children under the age of  
 24 nineteen years are to be listed as members and, in the ab-  
 25 sence of a protest by the named village pursuant to subsection

1 (b) (2) hereof, such designa-  
 2 a Native village does protes-  
 3 the Commission shall deter-  
 4 which the Native and his chil-  
 5 are members, and the burde-  
 6 be upon the individual. In  
 7 Commission shall give prior-  
 8 order: (1) to the village w-
