 12 9 (h) of this Act, to be violating any provision of this
 13 Act or of its articles of incorporation; and

14 (6) carry out any and all activities directed to-
 15 ward promoting the health, welfare, education and so-
 16 cial and economic development of Alaskan Natives and
 17 their descendants.

18 (j) The internal affairs of the Corporation shall be gov-
 19 erned in accordance with the laws of the State of Alaska
 20 relating to nonprofit membership corporations, except to
