 2 so organized shall be subject to the approval of the Commis-  
 3 sion, and for a period of ten years after the date of its organi-  
 4 zation, all amendments to the articles of incorporation must  
 5 be approved by the Commission and its annual budget shall  
 6 be subject to review by the Commission.

7 (k) The articles of incorporation for each Native vil-  
 8 lage shall include the following provisions—

9 (1) all persons shown as members of the Native vil-  
 10 lage on the final membership roll prepared in accordance  
 11 with section 7 (b) of this Act shall be entitled to mem-  
 12 bership or to ownership of stock, as the case may be,  
 13 in the village corporation: *Provided*, That the articles  
 14 of incorporation also may, but need not, authorize the  
 15 cancellation of memberships or stock and the issuance  
 16 of new memberships or stock to reflect deaths and births,  
 17 respectively, during the twenty-year period after De-  
 18 cember 31 of the year during which this Act becomes  
 19 law;

20 (2) for a period of at least twenty years after the  
 21 effective date of this Act, membership in a village cor-  
 22 poration shall be limited to Natives and their descend-  
 23 ants, and stock in a village corporation and any dividends  
 24 paid or distributions made with respect thereto shall not  
 25 be sold, pledged, subjected to a lien or judgment execu-

1 tion, assigned in present or  
 2 (except through inheritance  
 3 (3) the village corpora-  
 4 Natives and their descenda-  
 5 ance of family plans not re-
