 13 selected by a Native village or regional corporation, after
 14 deducting the cost of administration thereof, shall be paid
 15 by the Secretary to such village or corporation.

16 (c) After the selection by a Native village or regional
 17 corporation pursuant to sections 11 or 15 of public lands
 18 withdrawn in accordance with Section 10, but before the
 19 issuance of a patent thereto under section 12, such village or
 20 corporation shall have a right to lease or dispose of the lands
 21 and interests in lands so selected, including minerals, on the
 22 same terms and conditions (except that approval shall be by
 23 the Commission rather than by the Secretary) as an Indian
 24 tribe organized under section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
 25 (25 U.S.C. 476; 48 Stat. 987), may dispose of unallotted
