 6 board of directors of the regional corporation, and the coun-
 7 cil, board of directors or other governing body recognized by
 8 the Secretary as having authority to act for a Native village,
 9 shall have the same rights, powers, duties and authority as a
 10 tribal council possesses in acting for an organized tribe; the
 11 village land selection committee, elected pursuant to section
 12 11 (b) of this Act, shall be authorized to exercise the same
 13 rights, powers and authority, and assume the same duties, if
 14 the Secretary and the Corporation both approve. Notwith-
 15 standing any other provision of law, all payments or revenues
 16 attributable to the leasing or other disposition of selected
 17 lands in accordance with this subsection shall be paid directly
 18 to the Native village or regional corporation, as the case
 19 may be.

20 (d) After the patenting of selected lands pursuant to
 21 section 12 of this Act, the village and regional corporations
 22 may hold, manage, lease or dispose of such lands and inter-
 23 ests therein, including minerals, in accordance with the laws
 24 of the State: *Provided, however*, That for a period of ten
