 8 annually and deposited in the Fund the amount of any under-  
 9 payment, to be taken first from the share of mineral revenues  
 10 from public lands in Alaska paid as Federal grants-in-aid  
 11 to the State and, if such share is insufficient, from any other  
 12 funds paid to the State of Alaska by the United States.

13 REVOCATION OF RESERVATIONS; EXCEPTIONS

14 SEC. 15. (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of  
 15 law, and except where inconsistent with the provisions of  
 16 this Act, the various reserves set aside by legislation or by  
 17 Executive or secretarial order for Native use or for the ad-  
 18 ministration of Native affairs, including reserves created  
 19 under the Act of May 31, 1938 (52 Stat. 593), are hereby  
 20 revoked, subject to any valid existing rights: *Provided,*  
 21 That lands within any reserve which is revoked pursuant  
 22 to this subsection shall be deemed to be public lands as of  
 23 the effective date of this Act and subject to withdrawal in  
 24 accordance with section 10 hereof.
