5 REVIEW BY CONGRESS

6 SEC. 19. On or before March 1 of each year during the  
 7 twenty years following the effective date of this Act, the  
 8 Commission and the Secretary, respectively, shall submit  
 9 reports to Congress concerning the operation and implemen-  
 10 tation of this Act during the previous calendar year. Within  
 11 ninety days after the end of each five-year period following  
 12 enactment of this Act, the Commission and the Secretary  
 13 also shall submit to Congress, through the President, a joint  
 14 report on the status of the Natives and their organizations,  
 15 a summary of actions taken under this Act, and their re-  
 16 spective recommendations as may be appropriate for exten-  
 17 sion, amendment or clarification of any provisions of this Act.  
 18 This joint report and the Commission's annual report shall  
 19 include as an appendix all statements, memorandums, reports  
 20 and other written comments presented to the Commission  
 21 for forwarding to Congress by any Native village, corpora-  
 22 tion or association.
