CONGRESS

March 1 of each year during the
 effective date of this Act, the
 Secretary, respectively, shall submit
 a report on the operation and implemen-
 tation of the Act for the previous
 calendar year. Within
 each five-year period following
 the date of this Act, the Commission
 and the Secretary, through the
 President, a joint report to the
 President, the Senate, and the
 House of Representatives, and their
 recommendations may be appropriate
 for extension of any provisions of
 this Act. The Commission's annual
 report shall include statements,
 memorandums, reports, and
 recommendations presented to the
 Commission by any Native village,
 corporation, or other organization.

1 may be necessary to carry out the functions and responsibili-

 5 SEC. 21. The Commission and the Secretary are author-
 6 ized to issue and publish in the Federal Register, pursuant
 7 to the Administrative Procedures Act (5 U.S.C. 500 and
 8 following), such rules and regulations as may be necessary
 9 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

SAVINGS CLAUSE

 11 SEC. 22. Except as specifically provided for in this Act,
 12 nothing in this Act shall be construed as repealing any other
 13 provision of Federal law applicable to Alaska. To the extent
 14 that a conflict may exist between any provision of this Act
 15 and any other Federal laws applicable to Alaska, the pro-
 16 visions of this Act shall govern.
