SHI is Seeking Chaperones for the Latseen Summer Camp!

Who: Parent, school district employee, youth mentor or college student who is over the age of 21 may apply to serve as a 2018 Latseen Academy Chaperone. Priority will be given to Sealaska shareholders, but we encourage all to apply.

Job Responsibilities: Chaperones must be available to stay for the duration of the entire camp from July 6 to July 15, 2018 as well as teleconference into the Chaperone Meeting on June 15th at 9 a.m. Chaperones will be with students daily and the schedule will be agreed upon prior to the beginning of the Academy. The final schedule will be released during the first Chaperone Meeting.

Characteristics Needed:

- Serve as a positive role model for Alaska Native youth.
- Strive for mutual respect while being an effective communicator.
- Build self-esteem and motivation to relate well with youth.

Required Responsibilities and Duties

- Be accessible by phone at ALL times during the Academy. Provide contact numbers to the SHI Academy coordinators.
- Ensure that the youth is supervised at all times.

Other Duties

- Activities could include helping to clarify activities; playing games or sports; assisting in arts classes; and assisting on field trips.

Stipend: \$1,800 for the duration of the Latseen Academy paid on June 20, 2018. Additional funding may be provided if you are chaperoning students to the academy from a rural area along with paying for travel costs.
