






My Name Is

Name writing is a high level skill. Your child can be at any level to begin this activity– from scribbles to fully formed letters!

- Using writing utensils and the name strips provided, have your child write their name.
- Take this home, and hang it up. In a few months, see how far they have come with their name writing by comparing.

Here is an example of writing stages:
