The Box of Treasures Scholarship is intended to provide scholarship to Alaska Native students enrolling in Northwest Coast (NWC) Art courses. This Scholarship is meant to partially or fully cover tuition, course fees, and/or other fees directly connected to studying NWC Arts at the University of Alaska Southeast Juneau Campus. This is an Alaska Native preferred scholarship, but anyone may apply.

Please note that there is only enough funds to assist up to 10 students per Spring/Fall semester so we are limiting one scholarship per student a semester. This scholarship does not cover AKLA non-credit options.
