- Middle School / Junior High - Grades 6-8
- High School - Grades 9-12

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# Northwest Coast Juried Youth Art Exhibit Application

## Artist Waiver, Release and Certification

- 1) I agree to hold Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI), its employees, officers, and volunteers harmless from any and all claims I might have for personal injury or damages to or loss of my property while participating in the SHI Juried Youth Art Exhibit
- 2) I have read and agree to abide by the SHI Juried Youth Art Exhibit Guidelines and Rules
- 3) I understand that violation of these rules will result in immediate removal
- 4) I agree to comply with applicable federal, state and local laws and tax codes.
- 5) I agree to comply with Southeast Alaska Native traditional laws in respecting and acknowledging clan ownership of crests, names, songs and other such cultural and intellectual property of clans.
- 6) I certify that I am the original artist of all work to be sold or displayed at the Juried Youth Art Exhibit.
- 7) I understand that my art work, if selected, must arrive at Sealaska Heritage at the Walter Soboleff Building **no later than May 23, 2016** to ensure that appropriate preparations of the art can be made in time for the Exhibit. I understand that later arrivals, unless preapproved, are not guaranteed participation in the show.
- 8) I understand that if my art work, if selected, must be "Display Ready" when I send it to the exhibit. Artwork such as baskets, or wooden items can be sent as is. 2-dimensional art such as a painted design on paper, must be framed before sending it to SHI. I will contact SHI for directions if I am unsure if my piece is display ready or not.
- 9) I understand that art work cannot be temporarily removed from and returned to the exhibit for any purpose between the exhibit opening date and closing date.
- 10) Parents: I authorize the use of my child's name, biography, photos and video of their submitted work and of my child, for educational, promotional, and cultural purposes.

4. Commercially reproduced artwork is prohibited even if the artist produced the original.
5. Prints and bronze sculptures are allowed but must be hand pulled, carved or fabricated and limited to an edition of 100 copies, signed and numbered.
6. All artwork must be "display ready" (example: blankets must have attached sleeve so it can be hung from rod, designs on paper must be framed and have a secure hanging device attached to the back).
7. Because of the provisions of the Endangered Species Act, it is the responsibility of the artist to ensure any use of parts from an endangered species are explicitly allowed by law.
8. It is the responsibility of the artist to comply with the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (PL 101-644) which makes it unlawful to display for sale or to sell any product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian produced, an Indian product of a particular Indian tribe or Indian arts and craft organization. The law further provides that the term "Indian" means any individual who is a member of a federally or state recognized Indian Tribe or is certified as an Indian artisan by an Indian Tribe.

#### Artwork Labels:

Each piece that is selected must have an identification label, including the name of the artist, name of the artwork and date of production. Artwork without a label will be returned to the artist at his/her own expense. SHI is not responsible if labels become separated from the artwork.

#### Show Display:

1. Sealaska Heritage Institute shall be solely responsible for the display of entries that are accepted to be a part of the show.
2. Although SHI will exercise care in handling the artwork, we are not responsible for the loss or damage of work.
3. All work displayed shall identify the name of artist, title of the piece, medium, grade level, and price.
4. Artwork cannot be removed until the closing of the show, June 30, 2016

#### Shipping and Handling:

1. Accepted participants will be notified of object delivery date requirements with acceptance notification.
2. Artwork accepted for the show, if shipped, must be sent to SHI prepaid.
3. All pieces must be packaged individually. Do not combine shipping of multiple pieces.

Sale of Artwork:

1. All work selected for the show may be sold during the show (on consignment)
2. SHI takes a 20% commission off sales. Artists will be paid as soon as payments are processed.
3. Purchasers sign a Gallery Purchase agreement where they agree to let the piece remain in the exhibit and are assured that the piece will be mailed to them once the exhibit is dismantled.

GENERAL RULES:

1. Artists misrepresenting themselves or their art will be disqualified from the show.
2. SHI staff and sponsors cannot accept gifts from artists. Gifts can be donated to Sealaska Heritage Institute.
3. SHI will not be responsible for artwork or materials used in the displaying of artwork.
