What is Haa Yoo X̱atángi Deiyí?

- An immersive three-year language project for future teachers of Lingít Yoo X̱atángi (Tlingit language), Xaad Kíl (Haida language), or Sm'algyax (Tsimshian language).
- A full scholarship to the University of Alaska Southeast for 16 heritage language scholars including room, board, and tuition.
- Part-time employment providing additional language learning opportunities.

- Alaska Native students interested in an immersive language learning project and becoming a heritage language teacher.
- New and current UAS students are welcome.
- Applicants will need to apply to UAS and UAS Housing separately from this application.
