- Four-week paid counselor-in-training positions will provide student support with technology both in person and remotely through Zoom. Pay is \$500 per week.
- Sharing our Stories: Voices on the Land is a culture-based performing arts camp for students in grades 5-8. Students will learn to tell stories about our land and people that incorporate Lingít, ǂaad Kíl, and Sm'alg̃yax.
