What is Haa Yoo X̱'atángi Deiyí?

- An immersive three-year language program for future teachers of Lingít Yoo X̱'atángi (Tlingit language), Xaad Kíl (Haida language), or Sm'algyax (Tsimshian language).
- A full scholarship to the University of Alaska Southeast for 16 heritage language scholars including room, board, and tuition.
- Part-time employment providing additional language learning opportunities.

Who should apply?

- Alaska Native students interested in a wholly immersive program in their heritage language. No experience is required.
- New and current UAS students are welcome.
